

# Team K9 – Rules & Guidelines

- Team K9 participants must complete and email a Team Profile to [teamk9.us@gmail.com](mailto:teamk9.us@gmail.com) along with proof of current Rabies vaccine/certificate at least 10 days from first class date. (Team K9 participants will sign and date their profile form in person at the first class.)
- K9 partners must be healthy and free of any contagious illnesses including fleas, ticks, worms, or other parasites.
- All K9 partners must remain on leash.
- K9 partner may be handled by someone as young as 16 but only under active parental supervision. For the safety of all and to minimize distractions of each team, additional children or dogs are not permitted at class.
- K9s (and humans) should not display any type of behavior issues or aggressive nature towards others. Doing so can cause removal from classes without refund. You Are a Team - Humans are responsible for the development and well-being of their K9 partner. Your mood travels down the leash to your K9 partner.
- Team K9 classes are outdoors – please dress appropriately.
- Please use the restroom before coming to class. Facilities are not always available in the parks where classes are conducted.
- Please do not allow your K9 partner to eliminate on Team K9 equipment or in the general training vicinity. In the case of an accident on the equipment, please notify the instructor immediately.
- Team participants must pick-up after their K9 partner and dispose of the waste.
- Allow plenty of space between teams and do not allow your K9 partner to greet another dog face-to-face or engage in play with another dog during class time.
- Due to limited classes and sizes, makeup classes are not offered for classes individually missed. Please adjust your schedule so you can attend each class.
